Title: A Proof-of-Principle Clinical Study to Investigate the Efficacy of a Combination Treatment on Single and Repeated Nociceptive Stimuli
Rationale: Paracetamol and dextromethorphan was investigated in comparison to paracetamol alone in order to determine if dextromethorphan has any adjuvant analgesic activity in combination with paracetamol. It was hypothesised that this combination would result in an enhanced analgesic effect compared to paracetamol alone.
Phase: I
Study Period: 31st January 2005 to 16th June 2005
Study Design: This was a single centre, double-blind, randomised, three-way crossover, proof of-principle study conducted in normal, healthy adult subjects (males and females). Experimental tests included electrical stimulation to skin and muscle (single and repeated stimulation); mechanical pressure applied to the muscle and intra-muscular saline to induce referred cutaneous hyperalgesia. Pain assessments were determined pre- and post-dose. Subjects were screened and underwent training/familiarisation in the experimental tests within 14 days of the initial treatment visit. They then returned for three treatment visits, each separated by a minimum of 3 days and a maximum of 10 days. On each treatment day, subjects had fasted for 3 hours prior to dosing and were not allowed fluid intake for 1 hour prior to and 2 hours post-dosing. One hour prior to dosing, subjects received verbal familiarisation of the experimental tests. Baseline experimental tests commenced at 30 minutes (± 5 mins) prior to dosing. Following dosing with the assigned study treatment, experimental tests commenced at 1, 2, and 3 hours post-dose (all ± 5 mins). A follow-up visit was performed at the end of treatment visit 3.

Objectives:
Primary objective: To assess the effect of paracetamol and dextromethorphan compared to paracetamol alone on single and repeated nociceptive stimuli over time.
Secondary Objectives:
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> To assess the effect of paracetamol and dextromethorphan compared to placebo on single and repeated nociceptive stimuli over time. To assess the effect of paracetamol compared to placebo on single and repeated nociceptive stimuli over time. To assess the safety of paracetamol and dextromethorphan compared to paracetamol alone and to placebo, as assessed by the incidence and severity of adverse events (AEs).
Primary Outcome Endpoints:
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Temporal summation pain detection threshold (tsPDT) to electrical skin stimulation at 1, 2 and 3 hours. Area under the stimulus-response curve (at 1, 2 and 3 hours) to repeated electrical skin stimulation.
Secondary Outcome Endpoints:
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Temporal summation pain detection threshold (tsPDT) to electrical muscle stimulation at 1, 2 and 3 hours. Area under the stimulus-response curve (AUC) (at 1, 2 and 3 hours) to repeated electrical muscle stimulation. Single stimulus pain detection threshold (ssPDT) to electrical stimulation, at 1, 2 and 3 hours.

4. Single stimulus pain detection threshold to muscle stimulation, at 1, 2 and 3 hours.
5. Area under the stimulus-response curve (at 1, 2 and 3 hours) to single electrical stimulation.
6. Area under the stimulus-response curve (at 1, 2 and 3 hours) to single muscle stimulation.
7. Build up and after-sensation to a 10 sec 20 Hz stimulation (to skin and to muscle)
8. Build up and after-sensation to a 10 sec 2 Hz stimulation (to skin and to muscle)
9. Pressure Pain Threshold (PPT)
10. Pressure Pain Tolerance Threshold (PPT-tol): The PPT-tol was defined as the maximal intensity the subject has accepted.
11. Assessment of muscle pain following intra-muscular injection of hypertonic saline
12. Vaso-motor response to standardised cutaneous heating.

Statistical Methods:

For the primary efficacy variables (temporal summation pain detection threshold, and area under the stimulus-response curve to repeated electrical skin stimulation), it was planned to analyse these using an analysis of covariance model, with baseline as a covariate. After inspection of the data, it was apparent that the data were not normally distributed, and so the Wilcoxon signed rank test was used to analyse the primary efficacy variables. To take into account any baseline differences, the change from baseline rather than the absolute value was used as the endpoint for analysis. The Hodges-Lehmann method was used to construct 95% confidence intervals (CIs) for treatment differences. All statistical testing was two-sided at the 5% significance level. All secondary variables were analysed in the same way as the primary variables.
