Protocol number: FOL-003 - A Study to Explore the Effect of Controlled Cutaneous Perturbation and Pharmacologic Modulation for Inducing Follicular Neogenesis

This document is to indicate completion and closure of Study FOL-003, EudraCT number 2009-018191-34, sponsored by Follica, Inc. The study was completed on July 22, 2011.

A total of eighty (80) subjects were screened for this study. Fifteen (15) subjects failed to complete the screening process. Sixty-five (65) subjects completed the screening process and were randomized into the study, and sixty-two (62) subjects fully completed the trial. Three subjects discontinued the study early; two for withdrawal of informed consent (one of these due to a family emergency); and one subject was lost to follow-up. No subject discontinued for an adverse event.

No pediatric subjects were enrolled in the study. The mean age (\pm SD) of subjects in the study was 41.6 ± 10.1 with a range of 22 to 64.

Publication of study results is anticipated. An updated study summary with a link to the publication will be provided when publication occurs.
