The number of tumours classified as responding to treatment are reported as a proportion of the trial set with 95%CI at 12 weeks by randomised treatment group. Response to treatment is classified according to the WHO-RECIST criteria, where a response is either a complete response (disappearance of tumour) or a partial response (decrease in tumour volume of $\geq 30\%$ at 12 weeks). Non-response is either stable disease (neither complete nor partial criteria met), or progressive disease (increase in tumour volume with no complete response, partial response or stable response reported before increase, i.e. increase $\geq 20\%$).
