

To whom it may concern,

I am submitting this summary attachment for reporting the results of EudraCT study number 2016-003846-97 titled: "Phenotypic and genotypic characterization of a tension-type headache population".

In this study, the patient recruitment was extremely slow and as such together with GCP we decided it was appropriate to stop the study. There were no patients still receiving treatment at the time of early termination. This meant that due to the small number of participants recruited, we were not able to assess our primary endpoint.

Results

Before stopping the trial we included 3 chronic tension-type headache that were prescribed mirtazapine for prophylaxis of tension-type headache. One patient stopped after 1 month as the side-effects were too much. The other 2 participants completed the study. In addition, 7 healthy controls completed the study. Due to early termination of the study, the data was not analyzed.
