The Geboes Index is the highest grade with a sub-grade above 0 and ranges from 0.0 to 5.4, with higher scores indicating a more severe disease.

Scores: 0 = Structural (architectural change), 1 = Chronic inflammatory infiltrate, 2A = Lamina propria eosinophils, 2B = Lamina propria neutrophils, 3 = Neutrophils in epithelium, 4 = Crypt destruction, 5 = Erosion or ulceration.
